Enrollment Steps

- **Submit an application:** Create an <u>enrollment portal</u> account to fill out an application. Be sure to select Cascade Virtual Academy as your school when entering your information!
- Send a letter of intent: To enroll your student, you will need to submit a <u>Letter of Intent</u> by email to your Resident District. Please copy <u>cvafax@K12.com</u> on the email so our school has the required proof that your Resident District has been notified.
- Gather your supporting documents and upload them to the enrollment portal. Things you'll need:
 - · Your student's birth certificate
 - · Proof of residency, such as a utility bill showing your name and address
 - Medical records, i.e., immunization records or exemption (required for public school enrollment)
 - · Student transcripts from any previous school attendance

Receive approval

- Check your email for important information about your enrollment status and next steps.
- If your student is currently enrolled in school, they should remain enrolled while your application is processed and approved.
